

## **REMARKS**

THIS IS AN UNLICENSED, PRIVATE AIRFIELD, Expect dawn to dusk Microlight operations and Free-fall Skydiving up to FL150.

The grass areas are NOT regularly mown.

CAUTION the straw bales (up to 6ft high) surrounding the hovercraft area - ALONG THE EDGE of the RUNWAYS.

A/C with a wingspan > 11m may suffer wing strikes on vegetation.

Variable runway use is likely.
